Door de ingewikkeldeheid van de plannen en de ondoorzichtige werkwijze van de Europese Commissie is het verzet tegen de soevereiniteit-vereisten die bepaalde aanbieders de toegang tot Amerikaanse clouddiensten ontzeggen, pas laat op gang gekomen.

De pijn zit 'm in het EU Cloud Scheme (EUCS), een cybersecurity-raamwerk van het agentschap Enisa dat certificeringen instelt voor clouddiensten. Voorlopig zal dat op vrijwillige basis gaan. Maar verwacht wordt dat vanuit de veiligheidsrichtlijn NIS2 EUCS certificering impliciet (vanwege ketens) of expliciet verplicht zal worden.

Dat kan in principe van de ene dag op de andere gebeuren, zonder inmenging van het Europees Parlement. Bepaalde overhedsdiensten, ntsbedrijven, banen en andere aanbieders van kritieke infrastructuur kunnen dan niet meer in zee gaan met Amerikaanse cloudbedrijven.



Challenges preparation

- › Nothing public yet

- › Intended legal process combines steps
- › Starting the publication of the Implementing Act
- › 1 year for accreditation / authorization



Requirements for CAB's

[Art. 54 CSA]

- › ISO 17065 accredited
- › EUCS specific complemented with
 - Annex C: Competence requirements for CAB's
 - Considering ISO/IEC 17021-1 / 17020 and 17029
 - *PUA: legal + financial competences = Assurance level specific*
- › Penetration testing # *specific accreditation yet? ISO/IEC 17020/17025*
- › Review architecture, risk analysis, design and implementation of security measures, analysis development activities and system configurations
- › Pilot evaluation
- › Peer assessments



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
